### Example Guide: Starting an organization-wide accessibility program: A guide for Higher Education Institutions

- Introduction and background
- Multi-step process:
  1. A systematic appraisal of the current situation
  2. Considerations of alternatives for technology compliance and organizational culture
  3. Gaining executive support
  4. Establishing stakeholders and goals
  5. Designing, planning and implementing a new system
  6. Periodic updates based on monitoring of progress.
- + Contingency planning.
